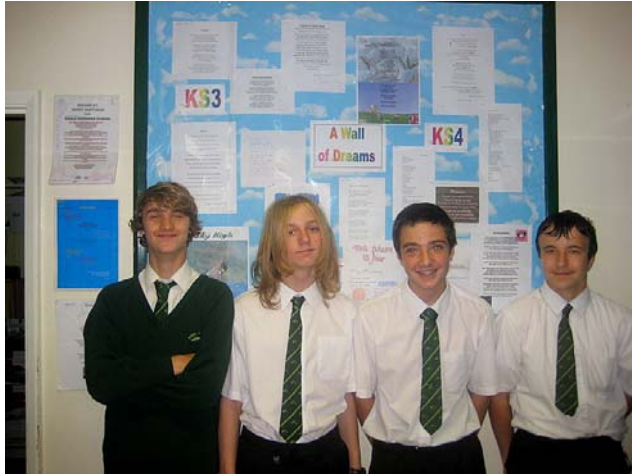
### 1<sup>ST</sup> WALL OF DREAMS
