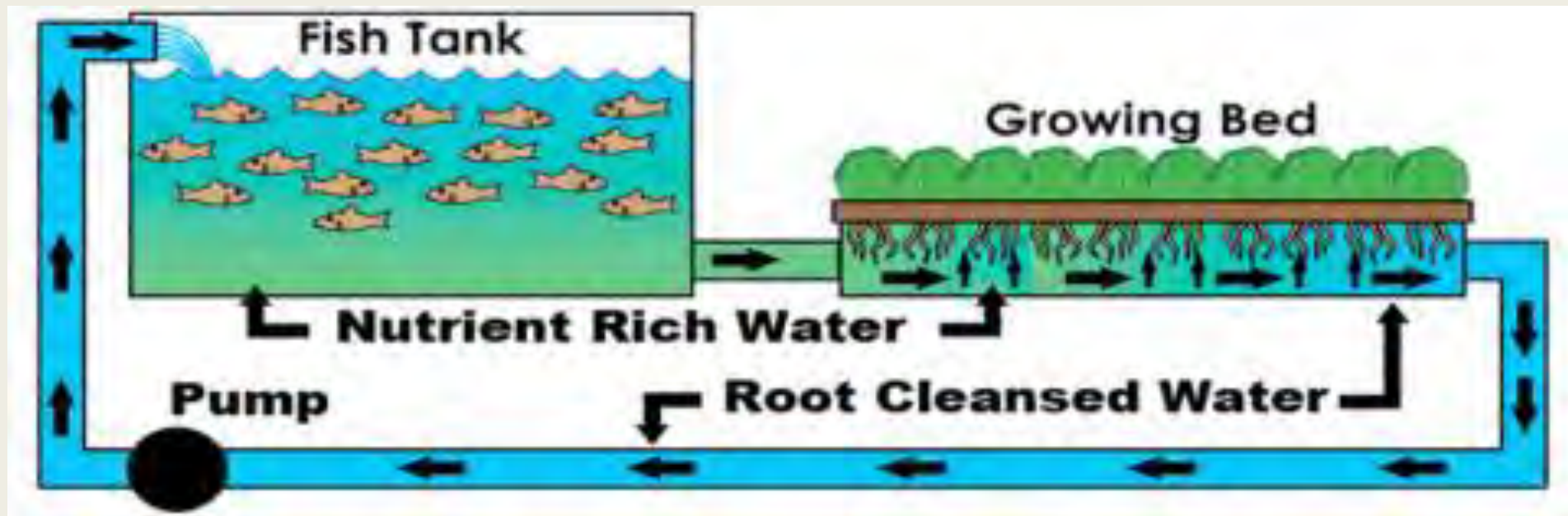

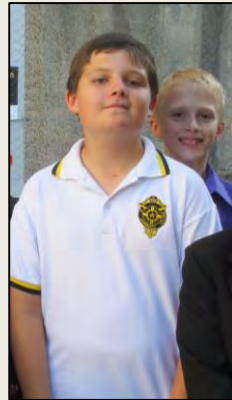

- **Leaders weigh many perspectives**

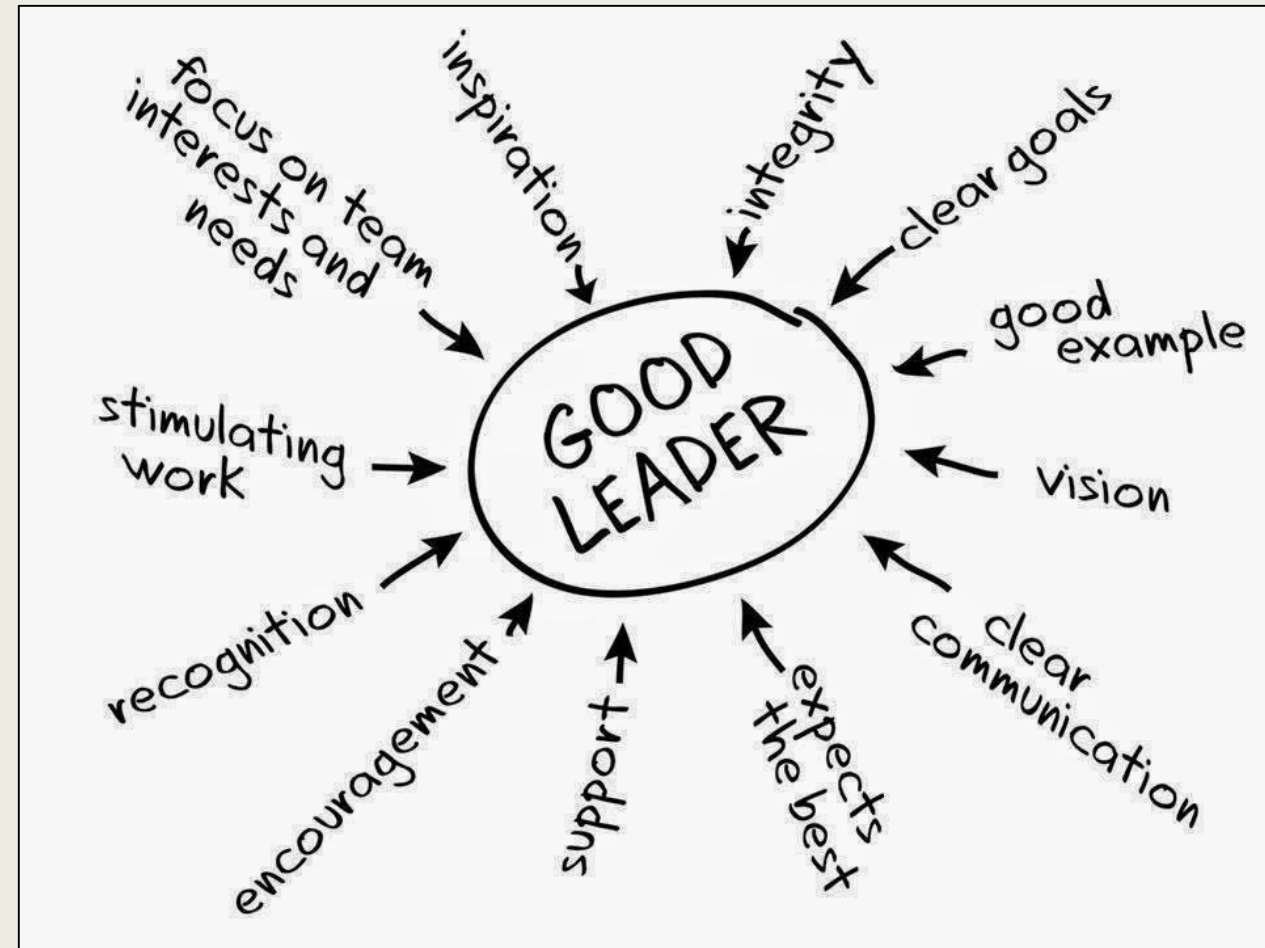
The leader weighs all the facts and acts with conviction when the time comes.
