

Sell an Item on your Desk (For STUDENT use)

(Be cryptic about what you are doing in the next activity)

1. Students are grouped in pairs
2. They choose an item from a bag without knowing the purpose of the activity.

Examples of items:

Push Pin	Paintbrush	Toothpick
Bottle cap	Fake fingernail	Chopsticks
Paperclip	Lego	Popsicle stick
Pencil sharpener	Packing peanut	Fake diamond
Tape roll	Binder clip	Leather
Spoon	Latex glove	Nail
Fork	Glass pebble	Screw
Knife	Pipe cleaner	Foam ball
Bobby Pin	Surgical face mask	Bandaid
Hair Bow	Penny	Qtip

3. In pairs, students are to create an elevator pitch to sell the item for use in a way it is not currently intended.
4. Requirements:
 - a. Enthusiasm
 - b. Expressiveness
 - c. Repurposing
 - d. Overall 30 Second Elevator Pitch
5. Each group gets 10 minutes to prepare their pitch.
6. Present with a 30 second timer
7. Each listening group rates the presenters with the top score being 4 – one point for each requirement fulfilled.
8. Winning group gets the most points
