

SELECTION

Recruit the sporty and well-respected boys first!

Once you have a group of well-respected boys on side, work on developing a simple routine and performing it for the School at a special event.

EXPOSURE

Ensure the boys perform for the School and keep performing. Once the other boys see the group perform, more will follow.



SMALL STEPS!

We started with eight boys.

Ten years later we have over 200!

We started with Senior School boys and one dance troupe. We now have six Dance Groups ranging from Year 1 to Year 12. We also offer solo's and duos. We compete in eisteddfods, take the boys on tour and perform regularly at corporate functions and for major school events.

We offer dance as part of the curriculum and have a part-time dance teacher.

Dance has been recognised as a sport and the School provides all the costuming and tuition at no extra cost to the parents.

TRADITION AND HISTORY

The Hutchins School was established in 1846 and has a proud history as one of Australia's oldest independent schools for boys and is a founding member of the International Boys' Schools Coalition .

When established Hutchins was modelled on traditional British schools.

BUILD THE ARTS

Prior to any dance groups starting at Hutchins we started a School of Performing Arts program where boys auditioned for a limited number of places in Music or Drama.

This has now been extended to offer places in Dance and Music Theatre.

We offer scholarships in all four areas.
