### Walks, river trips, parks and gardens

- Guided walks – the best way to appreciate the city [londonguidedwalks.co.uk](http://londonguidedwalks.co.uk)
- Walk through Cannon Street Station, along the pathway, cross the pedestrian bridge over the Thames and end up on the southern embankment, often with amazing street entertainers and great views up and down the river.
- Walk around Covent Garden, often with street entertainers.
- Thames Path Walk – from East to West London, and take in 1,000 years of history, all along the Thames.
- Walk along Regent's Canal
- London Parks – Hyde Park, Green Park, Regent's Park, St James' Park
- Sky Garden – London's highest garden (free but ticket required)
- Thames boat trip to Greenwich
- Walk along the South Bank – live music

## THINGS TO DO IN LONDON: SHOPPING TIPS



### St Christopher's Place

Don't go to Oxford Street. Cut through the narrow alleyway into St Christopher's Place near the Bond Street tube station on Oxford Street and meander through the cafés, restaurants and boutique shops that are tucked away behind.

### Marylebone High Street

From St Christopher's Place, continue north up Marylebone High Street, not forgetting to divert past The Ginger Pig deli/butchers and La Fromagerie cheese shop in Moxon Street. The Shops on Marylebone High Street include many famous fashion and design brands. The excellent Daunt Books organises books by geographical region in a beautiful Edwardian setting. Their books bags are a well-known fashion statement.

## TIPS FOR GETTING AROUND



- City Mapper is a great app to help with all travel options. Particularly useful for navigating any planned engineering works across that weekend, or for bus routes which are not as easy to plot as the tube. [www.citymapper.com](http://www.citymapper.com)
- TFL app to help with tube and bus connections.
- Oyster cards for those without contactless
- The best way to get around central London is to walk. It is surprisingly compact and sometimes walking on shorter journeys can be quicker than the Tube.
- Hire an electric bike but make sure you a) wear a helmet and b) cycle on the left.
