



# IBSC Member Story: Exploring the Journey from Boyhood to Manhood Through Research & Music at St. Christopher's

Singers in the <u>St. Christopher's School</u> (United States) Glee Club spent the past year working closely with musician and alumnus Wells Hanley, the school's 2022-23 Artist-in-Residence. Through research conducted in collaboration with <u>The Center for the Study of Boys</u>, students in the middle and upper schools shared insight into the pressures they feel in their own journey from boyhood to manhood. Hanley synthesized these perspectives through the lens of the mythic *Hero's Journey* and composed *The Call*, which he premiered with the ensemble in May 2023. <u>His talk</u> and the final performance offered a wonderful example of how research into the lived experiences of our boys can inform the creation of a powerful piece of art. <u>Watch The Call</u>.
